

Sonoma County Standard 1st DUI Court & DMV Wrap Sheet

For use only as an aid during face-to-face lawyer-client consultation; applicability to your unique situation may vary. Assumes otherwise valid California license, adult alcohol-related misdemeanor DUI, not Wet Reckless, & no priors, refusal, other special enhancements, or violence alleged.

(1) DMV Suspension Starts Substantially Before Court Conviction

Get H-6 Printout from DMV and Court Case # from lawyer

Enroll in DDP (bring H-6) early in first 30 days of suspension so DMV can confirm enrollment by 31st day. Begin attending classes within 21 days of enrollment

Get SR-22 Insurance: shop insurance companies, confirm if company transmitting SR-22 directly to DMV or mailing to you for filing in person at DMV on 31st day

Go to DMV & Get Restricted Class C License: on 31st day (or after), confirm SR-22, DDP enrollment, pay fee and get new temp (DMV mails permanent within weeks)

After Court Conviction

Sign up for Work Release: (if jail sentenced) call 565-8281 and go sign up for jail alternative within 10 days of conviction, **OR, turn yourself in** at North County Detention Facility (near airport) as shown on Minute Sheet

Confirm Fine payment arrangements with Court at 521-6500 within 30 days

Go to DMV & Get New Restricted License: Check with DMV within 6-10 days of conviction whether new restricted license required

(2) DMV Suspension & Court Conviction on or Around Same Day

Get Minute Sheet from lawyer

Sign up for Work Release: (if jail sentenced) call 565-8281 and go sign up for jail alternative within 10 days of conviction, **OR, turn yourself in** at North County Detention Facility (near airport) as shown on Minute Sheet

Enroll in DDP (req'd in 1st 21 days) bring Minute Sheet, go ASAP in first 30 days so DMV can confirm enrollment by 31st day. Begin attending classes within 21 days of enrollment

Get SR-22 Insurance: shop insurance companies, confirm if company transmitting SR-22 directly to DMV or mailing to you for filing in person at DMV on 31st day

Confirm Fine payment arrangements with Court at 521-6500 within 30 days of sentencing

Go to DMV & Get Restricted Class C License: on 31st day (or after), confirm SR-22, DDP enrollment, pay fee and get new temp (DMV mails permanent within weeks)

(3) Court Conviction Substantially Before DMV Suspension Starts

Get Minute Sheet from lawyer

Sign up for Work Release: (if jail sentenced) call 565-8281 and go sign up for jail alternative within 10 days of conviction, **OR, turn yourself in** at North County Detention Facility (near airport) as shown on Minute Sheet

Enroll in DDP immediately: (req'd in 1st 21 days) bring Minute Sheet to sign up, and begin attending classes within 21 days of enrollment

Get SR-22 Insurance: shop insurance companies, confirm company immediately transmitting SR-22 directly to DMV or mailing to you for filing ASAP in person at DMV.

Go to DMV & Get Restricted Class C License ASAP, confirm SR-22, DDP enrollment, pay fee (DMV mails permanent within weeks)

Confirm Fine payment arrangements with Court at 521-6500 within 30 days of sentencing

After DMV Suspension Start Date

Go to DMV & Get New Restricted License on 31st day of DMV suspension start date by appearing at DMV and paying new reissue fee
