FACT-Forensic Assertive Community Treatment

Eligibility for FACT:

- Individuals with diagnoses of serious and persistent mental illness
- On Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Social Security Disability Income (SSDI) or appears to meet criteria for same as a result of mental illness and functional impairments
- Charged with misdemeanors, usually referred while in custody
- Eligible for probation, ideally eligible for about three years
- Maximum number of clients in program-50
- Resident of Sonoma County

Services we provide:

- Medication evaluation, education, treatment and monitoring, daily observation if needed.
 Program aims to teach clients to access medications independently
- Individual counseling, case management, referrals to community resources
- Chemical testing to support substance abuse treatment and meet probation requirement of sobriety
- Group program includes: Substance Abuse Recovery, Support Groups for men and women, getting off Rep Payee/budgeting, Volunteering/Employment skills, Smoking Cessation, Symptom Management/Medication Education, Transitional Age Youth group, Getting to Drive, Social/Recreation group, Criminal Offender group, Mentor group
- Coverage 24/7 including weekend and holiday medication monitoring
- Supported housing through Buckelew
- Weekly Mental Health Court evaluates and tracks client's progress

Staff includes:

- <u>Full time</u>: RN, three MFT/MFTI clinicians, Probation Officer, Senior Office Assistant, Program Manager
- Part time: Psychiatrist
